

The fastest growing segment of the US population are older adults. Every day 10,000 people in the US turn 65 and among older adults the fastest growing demographic are those aged 85+. In our 45th year, Senior Coastsiders continues to adapt and evolve to serve the needs of the growing population of older adults on the Coast. We are pleased to share with you this report that highlights our activites and accomplishments during the fiscal year ended June 30, 2022.

### **KEEPING THE DREAM ALIVE**

### Dear Friends of Senior Coastsiders,

Senior Coastsiders resumed in-person services in July 2021, which was much earlier than many other senior centers in the County. We were

proactive because our participants told us how much they missed being at the Center and socializing with others. However, to be sensitive to the various risk tolerances of people, we continue to provide options for participants to receive meals, programs, and services in their homes in addition to at the Center.

In January 2022 the Board approved the adoption of seven organizational values that we incorporate in all the work we do:

- **Community** We collaborate with community-based instructors who provide classes and activites that promote the physical, mental, social, and economic well-being of Coastside older adults. We partner with the County to provide the meals we home deliver and serve in our dining room. We've set ourselves up as a Community Resilience Hub to shelter people in the event of extreme heat or poor air quality and we are working closely with the City of Half Moon Bay and various civic leaders to make the Coastside more age friendly.
- **Compassion** We serve our community with respect, patience, kindness, and empathy through the provision of our various programs - care management, home repairs, classes and activities, transportation, and pet buddy support.
- **Inclusion** We have increased our capacity to serve non-English speaking older adults by hiring a part time Community Liaison who speaks Mandarin and Cantonese, and a full time Office Manager who speaks Spanish.
- **Gratitude** We have hosted celebration events to express our appreciation of the contributions our participants and donors make to the vitality and richness of the Coast.
- **Volunteering** We value the support of our amazing volunteers who have dedicated thousands of hours to ensuring we can fulfill our mission of promoting successful aging for Coastside seniors.
- **Stewardship** Despite the recent financial and economic turmoil, we continue to responsibly manage the funds, resources and time entrusted to us by our donors, partners, local government, and volunteers. Thanks to our committed donors and funders Senior Coastsiders is on solid footing.
- **Innovation** We have implemented a cloud based senior center management system in which participants and volunteers use a touch screen at the front desk to sign up for events, meals, and volunteer hours. This has helped us better understand who is visiting the Center, when and why, and increased our volunteer management efficiency.


Looking to the future, we are using a collaborative approach with participants, donors, staff, volunteers, and board members to craft our vision statement for 2030 and beyond. This will ensure we can optimally position our organization to meet the needs of a growing and increasingly diverse older adult population. On a more practical note, we have entered into a contract to lease a wheelchair accessible vehicle that we will use to bring participants to and from the Center, to local grocery stores, and on trips and outings.

The demand for our services remains high and we are grateful to the individuals, foundations and local governments who have supported us financially. Thank you for your continued generosity - we couldn't do our work without vou!





# Volunteer Your Time, Talent & Heart


